

I am concerned with the Statement form the Parish Council regarding the Car Park at the Parish Hall.

I agree with David Simons.

The only way the Car Park could have been constructed would be using a sustainable drainage installation ie self draining. This would be a requirement to comply with an acceptable Water Management Statement prepared as part of the Plannning Permission and is recognised good practice.

Bredon gravel is a recognised surfacing material to achieve a self drainage characteristic. Its disadvantage is that it takes time to bed in so early intensive use will degrade the surface.

Could the Parish Council offer guidance as to where they get the information that drainage of the car park is a problem and more particularly, what solution adopting a sustainable drainage approach they propose to utilise as an alternative. I am concerned that the Parish Council may be receiving advice from someone who does not know anything about designing a sustainable drainage installation but wants to generate work for themselves.
